^{*} Knowledge can be evaluated by mark or by credit. Usually examination and theses are evaluated by mark. Subjects of study programmes can be evaluated by credits, which aim to test student's acquired knowledge. Student passes the credit, if he/she proves that has acquired no less than 50 % of the subject's knowledge.
