ACCOMODATION

90% of students live in dormitories mostly owned by universities. It is the cheapest and the more comfortable option.

The most famous public dormitory has a cost of around 60eu per month and are:

- **EKONOM:** it is the newest one, the price is around 60 EU per month. The application is by e-mail.
- **BERNOLAK:** old dormitory close to the centre refurbished recently.
- **STURA MLYNY :** quiet neighbourhood surrounded by greenery and just 10 minutes by public transport to the center.

STUDENT RESIDENCE is a private dormitory, located in the city center in Petržalka area. The price is around 200 EU for a double room and 300EU for a single room; it includes storage bed, blankets, furniture and also a common relaxing and ludic place.

COST OF LIVING AND FUNDING

- COST OF LIVING:
 - Meal in a inexpensive restaurant: 6EU
 - Local transport- one way: 90 cents
 - Average monthly cost (transport, food, entertainment..): 500 EU

 - University funding get under request and through ISEE
 - Erasmus scholarship of 200EU under particular conditions

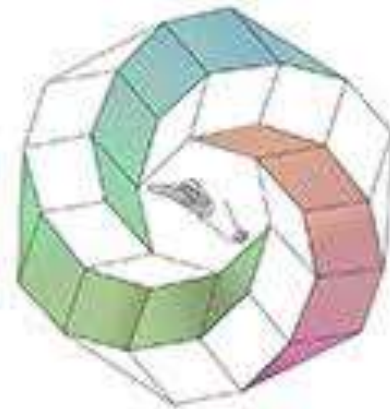

EUBA'S INTERNATIONAL ACTIVITIES

- The University of Economics in Bratislava is the oldest and the biggest university of economics in Slovakia established in the 1940, now it counts more than 8.000 students.
- UEBA has a network of 111 partner universities in 41 countries, in all the continents. It collaborates with:
 - Erasmus+ with all the European countries
 - associations for double diplomas such as HERMES and CIDD.
- The number of exchange students coming from abroad is 500 most of them from France, Spain and Mexico.

- There are five masters programme taught in English available for the DD: International Finance, General Management, Economic Diplomacy, Global Finance and MBA.
- All the curriculum consists on mandatory and elective courses.
- MIF and MGF: the mandatory courses provide grounding in microeconomics, finance, taxation, and controlling, giving student the opportunity to specialise according to their preference choosing some of the electives.
- EDIP and MGM: the programme will give a strong foundation in core disciplines such as economics, finance, management, diplomacy, international relations and foreign languages. The wide range optional courses to enrich the study experience by different perspectives.

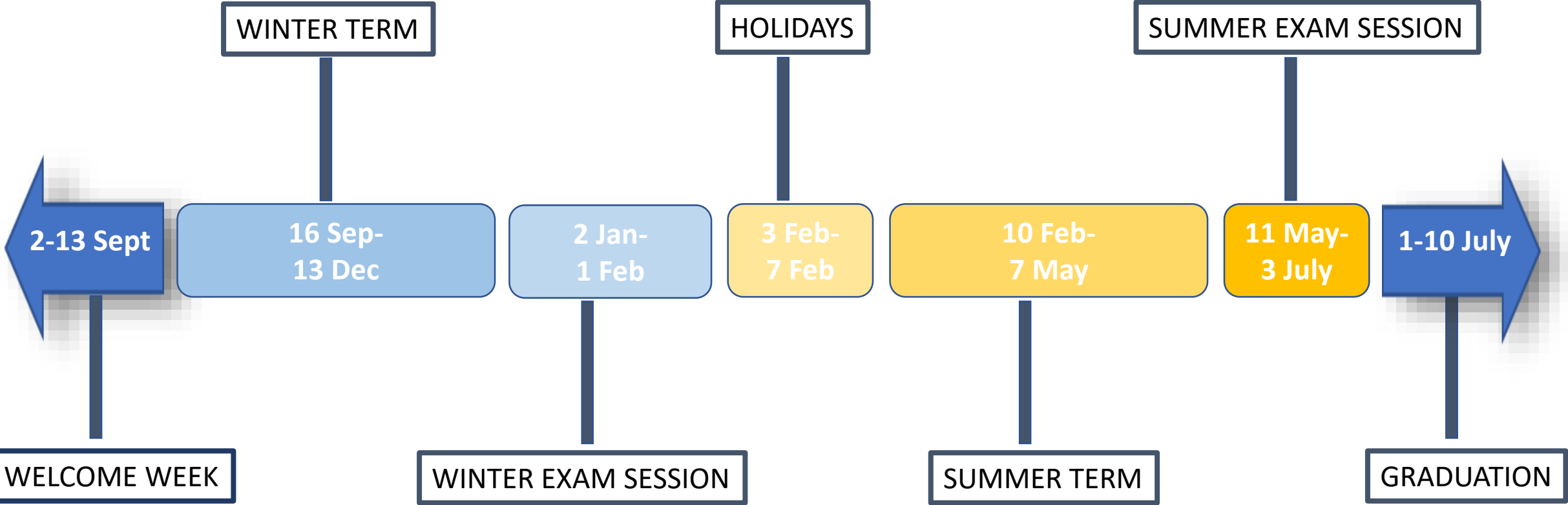
APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Completed application form
- Official transcript of records in English; all first year subject must be completed
- Proof of proficiency in English (IELTS 6.0 or comparable, native speakers and applicants who studied at least 1 semester in English are exempt)
- Short CV or resume
- Copy of an identity card or passport
- Motivation letter

The application period: is from the 1 of January to the 30 of April
