



## Living in Strasbourg

#### Housing

- Rooms available in university dormitories (single/double, shared or private kitchen/bathroom) on a first come first served basis.
- Online housing application: June (Fall semester or Academic year) or November (Spring semester).
- Private housing available in proximity of the campus and the city center within walking/biking distance of the school. Regular public transportation (buses, trams) is also available.
- Student housing aid available based on your housing costs.
