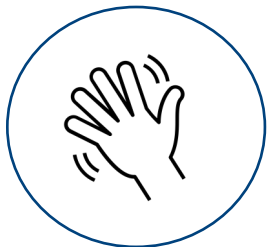

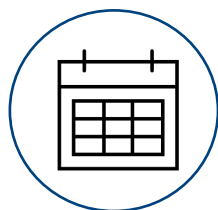

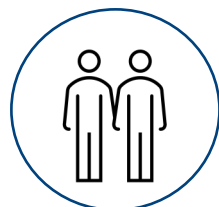


# Special Offer for Exchange Students

## **Trips & Excursions**

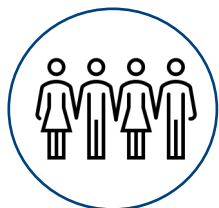

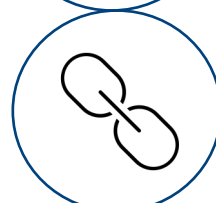
